Welcome to the latest newsletter for Scotland's Census 2022 ▶

- Following the publication of the first [results](#) in September 2023, work has continued to finalise the census database ahead of the topic reports to be published later this year.
- The next set of census statistics will be published in a series of 'topic' themes and the release [schedule](#) is available on the Scotland's Census website.
- The first theme will cover Ethnicity, National Identity, Language and Religion and will also include unrounded population estimates by single year of age and sex. These statistics will be **published in May 2024**.

Scotland's Census results – summer releases

Following the first release, the following topics will be published over the summer:

- Demography and migration
- Education
- Health, disability and unpaid care
- Housing
- Labour market and travel to work
- Sexual orientation and trans status or history
- Armed Forces veterans

Please keep an eye on the schedule page on the Scotland's Census website and future editions of this newsletter for updates on the order of the topics and month in which they will be published.

The actual date for each topic release will be confirmed **four weeks before publication.**
